Martha Sproul) from 'near Omagh', County Tyrone 2) sample 1494 who descends from Alexander Kinkead (c1810-1891, m. Jane Scott) who emigrated from County Tyrone, Ireland to Ohio, USA 3) sample 11194 who descends from Alexander Kinkead (m. Her sons' step grandfather was Alex Sailes who married Gladys Shand and lived in Port Alberni, Vancouver Island, British Columbia. James and Ellen Kincaid were Alex Sailes grandparents. The Sailes lived in the Port Coquitlam area. Betty reports that the bible was printed in 1874 and although very musty, it is still in super shape. The pages have yellowed but the spine is not broken and there are no loose pages. It is 6 1/2 inches by 4 inches and black in colour. Written inside the cover of the bible is: **Ellen Bates**, 32 Wapping Lane, Londonderry Ireland. On the next page is the births of the following children:

**Robert Kincaid** born 19th August at No 1 Greenslates Row Derry 1889

**Jane Kincaid** born 13th September at 38 Wapping Lane Derry 1890.

**Maggie Kincaid** born 6th September at 34 Wapping Lane Derry 1892

**George Kincaid** born 29th October at 34 Wapping Lane Derry 1893

**Lizzie Kincaid** born 16th November at 34 Wapping Lane Derry 1894

Further into the bible, at the beginning of the New Testament, is their marriage record as follows:
