To save space the characters // were used to indicate a new paragraph. Male names with a red § following their names indicates that evidence suggests that their line failed due to an early death or due to there being no legitimate children. Sources follow the record in [].

Thanks also to others specifically noted within the text as having made information available. Cite them if you wish to use their contributed information.

Finally, bear in mind that with this many pages of entered information, there are bound to be typos in this paper. This is basically a draft document. If something is of interest to your research, consult the original record to confirm the correct information. If anyone finds a typo or error then please let me know. The Drumholm Kincaids have several samples in the Kincaid DNA project at Family Tree DNA and they fall under Group C, Set 1 Kincaids. Samples 1648, 2566, 7529 descend from John Kincaid and Catherine Coulter; sample 4749 descends from George Kincaid and Elizabeth Virtue; and sample 88507 descends from Joseph Kincaid and Elizabeth Squire. Sample 76321 is also part of Group C, Set 1 and descends from a Robert Kincaid born circa 1825 in county Donegal.

- **George Kincade**, son of **Andrew Kincade**, married **Elizabeth Thompson**, daughter of Thomas Thompson, on 14 November 1787 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- If one takes 20 years to a generation, since he was married in 1787 it is assumed that he was born about 1767 and his father, Andrew, about 1747. He would thus fit as a son of Andrew Kincaid who was son of George Kincaid.

 - George, son of George Kincaid, was baptized on 24 January 1748 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

Robert Kincade of Mullinacross.

- **It is not certain**, but he was likely the **Robert Kincaid** of Drumhome Parish, County Donegal who is listed in the Flax Grower's lists for 1796.

 - On 27 September 1796, Susanna Kincaid, daughter of Robert Kincaid, was married to William Thompson, son of Matthew Thompson, at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- ii. **William Kincade.**
 - William, son of Robert Kincade and Jane Graham of Mullinacross, was baptized on 22 May 1783 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- iii. Isabella Kincade.
 - Isabella, daughter of Robert Kincade and Jane Graham of Birrah, was baptized on 18 October 1785 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - On 31 May 1804, Isabella Kincaid, daughter of Robert Kincaid, was married to John Heron, son of John Heron, at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- iv. **George Kincade.**
 - George, son of Robert Kincade and Jane Graham of Mullinacross, was baptized on 27 December 1787 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- vi. Jane Kincade.
 - Jane, daughter of Robert Kincaid and Jane Graham of Mullinacross, was baptized on 10 March 1790 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

- ix. Margaret Kincade.
 - Margaret, daughter of Robert Kincaid and Jane Graham of Mullinacross, was baptized on 6 December 1814 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

John Kincade.

- **It is not certain** but he was likely the John Kinkead of Drumhome Parish, County Donegal who is listed in the Flax Grower's lists for 1796.
- i. **Thomas Kincaid** of Mullinacross.
 - Jacqueline Wilson's family tree chart has this as the oldest son of John Kincaid and Ann Coulter of Mullinacross.
 - **Thomas Kincade**, son of John Kincade, married **Jane McCrerry**, daughter of William McCrerry on 5 November 1806 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - i. **Isabella Kincade**.
 - Isabella, daughter of Thomas Kincaid and Jane McCrerry of Mullinacross, was baptized on 24 June 1809 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - ii. **William Kincade**.
 - William, son of of Thomas Kincade and Jane McCrerry of Mullinacross, was baptized on 18 March 1811 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - iii. **John Kincade**.
 - John, son of Thomas Kincaid and Jane McCrerry of Mullinacross, was baptized on 26 March 1813 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - iv. Margaret Kincade.
 - Margaret, daughter of Thomas Kincaid and Jane McGregory, was baptized on 7 August 1814 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - **It is not certain** but it is assumed that McGregory was a misread of McCrerry.
- ii. **Robert Kincade**.
 - Robert, son of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Mullinacross, was baptized on 4 April 1784 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - **Robert Kincaid**, son of **John Kincaid**, married **Anne Young**, daughter of Patrick Young, on 28 August 1810 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - His age fits with the Robert who was the son of John Kincade and Ann Coulter. Thomas Garfield Kincaid wrote to Joseph W. Kincaid of Rexton on 8 September 1887 that his great grandfather, Robert Kincaid, set sail for America with his family from Donegal, June 12, 1842. The ship was the Spring Hill, and the Captain Wm Wilson. He settled in Hungerford Township in Hastings County, Ontario. He says his great great grandfather was John Kincaid of Mullinacross, Donegal.
 - i. **Eleanor Kincade**.
 - Eleanor, daughter of Robert Kincaid and Ann Young of Lacklum, was baptized on 2 July 1811 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - ii. **Elizabeth Kincade**.
 - Elizabeth, daughter of Robert Kincade and Anne Young of Ballintra, was baptized on 28 November 1813 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - iii. **Margaret Kincade**.
 - Margaret, daughter of Robert Kincade and Anne Young of Dramark, was baptized on 4 April 1820 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - iv. **Robert Kincade**.
 - Rob[er]t, son of Rob[er]t Kincade and Ann Young of Dromark, was baptized on 27 July 1822 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - v. **Catherine Kincade**.
 - Catherine, daughter of Rob[er]t Kincade and Ann Young of Dromark, was baptized on 29

May 1824 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

- iii. **Andrew Kincade.**
 - Andrew, son of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Mullinacross, was baptized on 29 December 1785 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - **Andrew Kincade**, son of **John Kincade**, married **Elizabeth McClintock**, formerly widow Bearie, on 28 September 1815 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - The family bible of Andrew notes that he had two daughters. This all corresponds with the Andrew Kincaid who married Elizabeth McClintock.
- i. Catherine Kincaid.
 - Catherine, daughter of And[re]w and Elizabeth Kincade of Lacklum, was baptized on 11 September 1817 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- ii. Elizabeth Kincaid.
 - Elizabeth, daughter of And[re]w Kincade and Elisabeth McClintock of Drumrad, was baptized on 10 April 1820 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- iv. **Patrick Kincade.**
 - Patrick, son of John Kincade and Anne Coulter of Mullinacross, was baptized on 12 July 1787 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - Thomas Garfield Kincaid has a copy of Patrick Kincaid's family bible. In it is the following:

 - Anne Kincaid of Lacklum, Drumhome death is recorded in the Parish registers on 12 June 1842.

 - Andrew, son of Patt Kincade and Ann Love of Lacklum, was baptized on 23 December 1822 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- ii. **James Kincade.**
 - James, son of Patrick Kincaid and Ann Love of Lacklum, was baptized on 23 March 1825 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- iii. **Alexander Kincade.**
 - Alexander, son of Patrick and Ann Kincade, was baptized on 22 March 1827 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

- v. Eleanor Kincade.
 - Eleanor, daughter of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Mullinacross, was baptized on 22 April 1789 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- vi. Margaret Kincade.
 - Margaret, daughter of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Mullinacross, was baptized on 15 January 1791 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- vii. Charles Kincade.
 - Charles, son of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Lacklum, was baptized on 23 February 1792 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - **It is not certain** but he likely died young as a later child was also named Charles.
- viii. **John Kincade.**
 - John, son of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Mullinacross, was baptized on 12 July 1795 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- ix. **George Kincade.**
 - George, son of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Lacklum, was baptized on 29 December 1796 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- x. **Charles Kincade.**
 - Charles, son of John Kincade and Ann Coulter of Lacklum, was baptized on 14 January 1799 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - On __ January 1854, **Mary Kincaid**, a full age spinster of Carnamugagh; daughter of **Charles Kincaid**, land steward, was married to **John Elliott**, a full age bachelor labourer of Carnamugagh, son of Robert Elliott, labourer, at the Parish Church, Conwall Parish, County Donegal, according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the United Church of England and Ireland by license by Richard Smith, curate. Mary gave her mark. The witnesses were Robert Strain and John Carson? [Ireland. Civil Registrations of Marriages. Letterkenny District, 1854, vol. 6, p. 578, no. 60; LDS film no. 101357].

John Kincade of Mullinacross.

 - John, son of John Kincade and Mary Love of Mullinacross, was baptized on 18 February 1785 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - **It is not certain** but Mary Love was likely a trascription error for Marg as in Margaret.
- ii. Frances Kincade.
 - Frances, daughter of John Kincade and Margaret Love of Mullinacross, was baptized on 19 July 1787 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - **Frances Kincade**, daughter of **John Kincade**, married **William Ferrall**, son of John Ferrall, on 12 January 1809 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- iii. **Joseph Kincade.**
 - Joseph, son of John Kincade and Margaret Love of Mullinacross, was baptized on 16 December 1789 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- iv. **Robert Kincade.**
 - Robert, son of John Kincade and Margaret Love of Mullinacross, was baptized on 26 August 1792 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

Thomas Kincaid. He married Margaret Ross.

- i. **John Kincaid (see Glasgow, Scotland Kincaids)**
 - The Statutory Death Registers records John Kincaid's death on 13 February 1866 at 72 Ann Street, Greenock being a 65 year old shipyard labourer, **son of the deceased Thomas Kincaid, weaver, and the deceased Margaret Ross and widower of Catherine Morrow**. His daughter Mary Ann

Gordon was present at his death [GROS, West District of Greenock, Renfrew County, 564/03 0092. p. 31, no. 92].

- i. **George Kincaid.**
 - On 24 December 1870, **George Kincaid**, a full age bachelor tradesman of Donegal; son of **John Kincaid**, tradesman, was married to **Mary Ann Ewen**, a full age spinster tradesman's daughter of Donegal, daughter of Andrew Ewen, tradesman, at the 2nd Presbyterian Church, Killymard Parish, County Donegal, according to the Form and Discipline of the Presbyterian Church by licence by Robert Neilson. They both gave their marks. The witnesses were Charles Stevenson and William Gordon [Ireland. Civil Registrations of Marriages. Donegal District, 1870, vol. 17, p. 45, no. 35; LDS film no. 101569].
 - The Statutory Death Registers records the death of **George Kincaid** on 31 October 1897 at 20 Corn Street, Glasgow being a 48 year old blacking work stoker, **son of the deceased John Kincaid, iron foundry labourer, and the deceased Catherine Morrow and spouse of Mary Ann Ewing**. His widow Mary Ann Ewing was present at his death [GROS, Milton District, Glasgow, 644/08 0801. p. 267, no. 801].
- ii. Mary Ann Kincaid.
 - Mary Ann, daughter of Thomas Kincaid and Margaret Ross of Ballinakilla, was baptized on 29 August 1806 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- iii. Elizabeth Kincaid.
 - Elizabeth, daughter of Thomas Kincaid Margaret Ross of Forum East, was baptized on 11 January 1808 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

 - Rebecca, daughter of William and Rebecca Kincaid, farmer of Grahamstown, was born on 13 November 1841 and baptized on 12 December 1841 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - iii. Phebe Kincaid.
 - Phebe, daughter of William and Rebecca Kincaid of Grahamstown, was born on 7 December 1845 and baptized on 9 December 1845 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
 - iv. **William Kincaid.**
 - William, son of William and Rebecca Kincaid, farmer of Grahamstown, was born on 28 February 1848 and baptized on 9 April 1848 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

v. Ann Kincaid.

- Ann, daughter of William and Rebecca Kincaid of Grahamstown, was born on 3 June 1850 and baptized on 10 November 1850 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.

George Kincaid.

- The *Griffith Valuations* of 1857 records a George Kincaid as a tenant of George Knox for house, offices and 13 acres 2 roods and 5 perches of land valued at £8/10/0 at map reference 9 in **Mullanacross townland**, Drumhome Parish, Ballyshannon Union.
- The *Griffith Valuations* of 1857 records a Thomas and George Kincaid as tenants of George Knox for house, offices and 2 roods and 20 perches of land valued at 5 shillings each respectively at map reference 11 in **Mullanacross townland**, Drumhome Parish, Ballyshannon Union.
- The *Griffith Valuations* of 1857 records a George Kincaid as a tenant of George Knox for a herd's house, offices and 60 acres 2 roods and 30 perches of land valued at £40/10/0 at map reference 11 in **Drumhome townland**, Drumhome Parish, Ballyshannon Union.
- The *Griffith Valuations* of 1857 records a George Kincaid as a tenant of George Knox for house and 11 acres 2 roods and 3 perches of land valued at £12/0/0 at map reference 8a in **Lacklom townland**, Drumhome Parish, Ballyshannon Union. George Kincaid had subtenants of James Campbell for a house valued at 5 shillings at map reference 8 b; James Leslie for a house valued at 5 shillings at map reference 8 c; and Daniel Cormack for a house valued at 10 shillings at map reference 8 d.

i. **John Kincaid.**

- John, son of George Kincaid and Mary Young of Mullinacross, was baptized on 13 June 1819 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
- **John Kincaid** married Dolly McGhee on - December 1846 at Ballintra, Parish of Drumholm, County Donegal.
