Sources follow the record in [].

- This line is represented by [sample no. 94749 of the Kincaid Y chromosome DNA project at FamilyTree DNA](#). He has two mutations, on the 1st 37 markers, different from [sample no. 2617 of the Kincaid Y chromosome DNA project at Family Tree DNA](#): DYS448 (18 to 19) and DYSCDY (37-38 to 37-39). Said sample no. 2617 is a documented descendant of Rev. Joseph Kinkead of Killinchy, County Down. Thus, Quinton was likely of the Barons Court, County Tyrone Kinkeads. The participant just has the first mutation different from Richard (Dick) Neil Kinkead who is sample no. 2562 of the same project. Dick is descended from Joseph Kinkead and Eleanor Willis who were married in Belmont County, Ohio on 9 May 1816.
- **Discussion:** Drumskillan is north of Londonderry just above Muff. Ture is on the north side of Drumskillan. Quinton Kincaid married **Jane Corbet**.
- *Sir Richard Griffith's Valuation of Ireland* for Muff Parish, County Donegal in 1858 records **Quintin Kincaid** as a tenant of Thomas Mulhern for a house, office and a garden of 25 perches, all valued as £0/10/0, at map references 15 b a in Drumskillan townland.
- There is 1851 census information surviving for the family of **Quanton Kinkead** in Ture, Muff Parish as part of a pension application in the early 1900s. It was as follows:

- The death of **Quintin Kincaid**, age 96, was recorded in Londonderry District in 1890 [General Index, Deaths Registered in Ireland during the Quarter ended 31 March, 1890, A to Y. Dublin: printed by Alexander Thom for Her Majesty's Stationery Office, 1890. LDS Film #0101596. Londonderry District, volume 2, page 158].
- **Quintin Kincaid** died at Drumskillan on 9 February 1890. He was a 96 year old farmer who died of old age (no medical attendant). The informant was James Hamilton of Drumskillan, Donegal, a neighbour, who was present at his death [Ireland. Civil Registrations of Deaths. Londerry District, 1890, no. 225, volume 2, page 158; registered on 14 February 1890 by H.M. Sproule, Registrar].
- i. **William Kincaid** (c1838 -).
 - **William Kinkead** appears in 1851 census abstracts as 13 years old.
 - **It is not certain** that this is the William C. Kinkaid of Sioux City, Iowa as outlined as follows. However, William C. Kinkaid was noted as being born in Londonderry in 1838. This matches well with William son of Quinton. That Quinton's son James also migrated to Sioux City, Iowa strongly supports the connection.
 - **William C. Kinkaid** was born on 21 March 1838 in Londonderry, County Derry, Ireland [Posted to Worldconnect on 8 September 2007 by John Rychlock (JRychlock@msn.com)].
 - **William C. Kinkaid** married **Alice Elizabeth Brown** (31 March 1855 Northbridge, Worchester County, Massachusetts, USA - 18 July 1923 Sioux City, Woodbury County, Iowa, USA) in 1885. She was the daughter of Charles Henry Brown and Hannah Whitney Cady. Alice Elizabeth Brown was first married to Alonzo Curtis Elder (b. 1853 Crawford, Washington County, Iowa, USA) and they had Charles Ernest Elder (b. 28 August 1875 Sioux City, Woodbury County, Iowa, USA), Laura Evelyn Elder (b. 21 April 1877 Sioux City, Woodbury County, Iowa, USA), and Lulu Defoe Elder (b. 17 February 1879 Sioux City, Woodbury County, Iowa, USA). Alice Elizabeth Brown next married Daniel Edward Gates about 1880 and they had Angie Annie Gates (b. 3 October 1882 Sioux City, Woodbury County, Iowa, USA) [Posted to Worldconnect on 8 September 2007 by John Rychlock (JRychlock@msn.com)].

 - On 12 September 1866, **Eliza Kincaid**, a full age spinster of Londonderry, daughter of **Quinton Kincaid**, labourer, was married to **James Wilson**, a full age bachelor labourer of Londonderry, son of Joseph Wilson, weaver at the cathedral in Templemore Parish, County Londonderry according to Rites and Ceremonies of the United Church of England and Ireland by license by W. M. Beresford. The witnesses were David Gilfillan and John Price [Ireland. Civil Registrations of Marriages. Londonderry District, 1866, vol. 6, p. -, no. 189, LDS film no. 101492].

 - **Rebecca Kincaid** appears in 1851 census abstracts as 5 years old.

 - **James Kincaid** appears in 1851 census abstracts as 2 years old.
 - The Statutory Marriage Registers records that **James Kincaid**, dock labourer, married **Isabella Hamilton**, at Saint Johns, Greenock on 9 July 1880 after publication according to the forms of the Scottish Episcopal Church. James was a 27 year old bachelor from 7 Main Street, Greenock, being the son of **Quinton Kinkaid**, farm labourer, and the deceased **Jane Corbett**. Isabella was a 17 year old spinster domestic servant from 11 Main Street, Greenock, being the daughter of James Hamilton, towns labourer, and Jane Morrow. The witnesses were James Hamilton and John Peacock. Isabella gave her mark [GROS, West District of Greenock, Renfrew County, 564/03 0139. p. 70, no. 139].
 - They appear in the 1881 census of East Greenock, County Renfrew at 7 Main Street. **James Kincaid** was a 31 year old dock labourer born in Ireland. **Isaba Kincaid** was 18 years old and born in Ireland. Their children at the time were **Mary Jane Kincaid**, age 7m and born in Greenock, Renfrew. They were in the household of Isabel's parents. In that family were James Hamilton, a 46 year old general labourer, born in Ireland; his wife Jane Hamilton, age 49 and born in Ireland; their son John Hamilton, a 21 year old unmarried dock labourer born in Ireland; and their son William Hamilton, a 15 year old unmarried sugar house labourer born in Ireland [1881 Census of East Greenock, Renfrew County, Scotland. Vol. 564-2, Enum. Dist. 2, page 19. LDS film no. 0203571].

 - **Eliza Kincaid** died at Drumskellan, Donegal on 2 August 1886. She was a 1 year & 9

month old female spinster daughter of James Kincaid a labourer who died from convulsions 2 days (certified). The informant was **Isabella Kincaid of Drumskillan, Donegal, her mother**, who was present at death [Ireland. Civil Registrations of Deaths. Londonderry District, 1886. no. 194, volume __, page 115; registered on 9 August 1886. https://civilrecords.irishgenealogy.ie/churchrecords/images/deaths_returns/deaths_1886/06241/4786714.pdf].

- iii. **Quintin Kincaid.**
- The Statutory Death Registers records **Quintin Kincaid's** death on 12 May 1887 at 9 Watt Street, Greenock being the 8 month old son of the **James Kincaid**, town's labourer, and **Isabella Hamilton**. His uncle Robert James Hamilton was present at his death [GROS, West District of Greenock, Renfrew County, 564/03 0245. p. 82, no. 245].

- **William Kinkaid** died on 15 February 1956 at Veterans Adm. Center, Sioux Falls, SD, USA after a 7 day stay. His usual residence was N. Sioux City, Union County, South Dakota. He was a white male truck driver, never married, age 67, born 29 October 1888 in South Dakota. He was the son of **James Kinkaid** and **Isabella Hamilton**. He was a World War I veteran. His social security number was 483-09-6337. He died of left carcinoma of prostate, terminal aortic endocarditis. He was buried in McCook Cemetery, N. Sioux City, South Dakota. Anderson Funeral Home, Elk Point, South Dakota took care of arrangements [Civil Registration of Deaths. Minnehaha County, South Dakota, USA. Book 22, page 22, no. 16484].

The witnesses were John Keys and Annie Donaldson [Marriages in the Ballyarnet Presbyterian Church as abstracted by George 'Noel' Kincaid of Belfast, Northern Ireland (george.kincade@ntlworld.com) and forwarded to Peter A. Kincaid by email dated 11 May 2006].

Ture is the townland adjacent to Drumskellan on the north. The list also contained the name of **Thomas Kinkaid** of Muff, County Donegal.

Mr. Loughrey, solicitor, appeared on behalf of the Marquis of Donegall, to prosecute **Thomas Kinkaid, of Drumskillan**, for trespass in pursuit of games (hares), at Iskaheen, on 4th November last. In a second summons Kinkaid was charged with killing a hare without legal qualification. Mr. Bradford appeared for Kinkaid. On examination of the title deeds it appeared that complainant had not reserved to himself the exclusive right to the game, but only a right to shoot over the ground. It was then sought to amend the summons by inserting Mr. J. B. Beresford's name along with complainant's. To this Mr. Bradford would not consent, and finally both cases were dismissed without prejudice. [Derry Journal, Londonderry, Ireland. Wednesday, 24 November 1880, page 7, column 3].
 - Burnfoot Petty Sessions were held on Friday, before Captain Norman, J.P. (chairman), Mr. M. P. Lloyd, J.P., Lieutenant-Colonel Knox, J.P., Capt. Dopping, J.P. Captain Martin, J.P., and Mr. Walsh, J.P. Mr. John James Simpson, Movable, Excise officer, prosecuted **Thomas Kincaid, Drumskillan**, who pleaded guilty for having a gun in his possession, and using the same without having the 10s Excise licence. The magistrates imposed the mitigated penalty of £5. [Derry Journal, Londonderry, Ireland. Monday, 24 December 1883].

The whiskey was there right enough.// Rev. Thomas M'Dermott, minister of Knowhead Presbyterian Church, told the District Justice that Kincaid was one of the best behaved men in the parish. Instead of taking part in the manufacture of poteen, he actually discouraged the traffic at all times. But on this occasion he had a cold, and was advised to get a little spirits to cure it. Had he had enough money he would have brought ordinary whiskey, but he was almost penniless.// The defendant, who is almost 70 years of age, said he could get witnesses to prove that he took no part in "stilling." He had had repeated invitations to be present when stills were being run in certain parts of the countryside, but had always refused to go.// The District Justice put the defendant under a rule of bail for twelve months--himself in £15, and one surety in £10, Rev. Mr. M'Dermott acting as the surety. [Derry Journal, Londonderry, Ireland. 17 January 1927, page 6, column 1].
